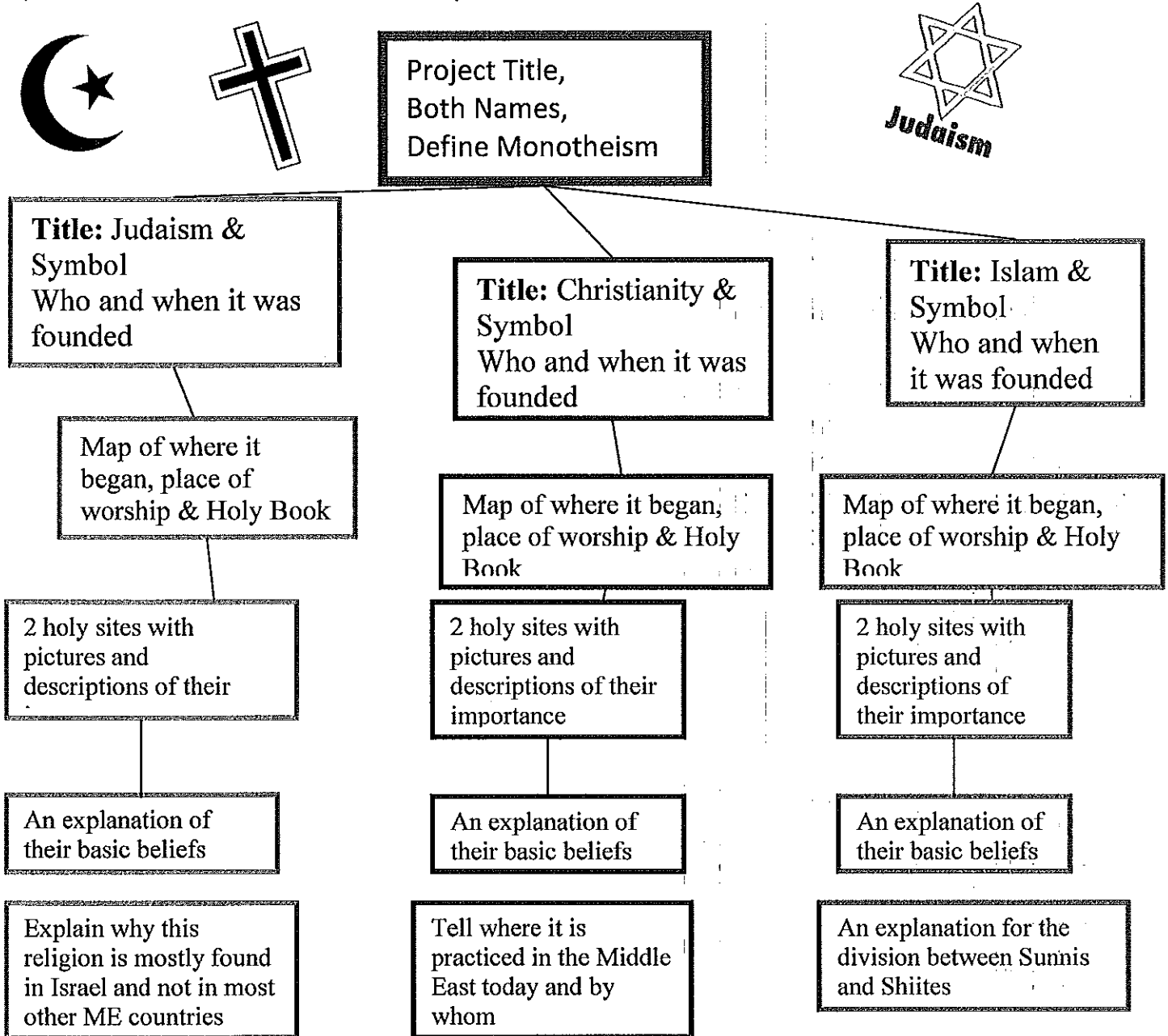


# Comparing Three Monotheistic Religions: Judaism, Christianity & Islam Power Point Project
